



Compass Opioid Prescribing + Treatment Guidance Toolkit

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#Clinicians across the nation continue to face one of the most devastating #publichealth crises in decades: the overuse and abuse of prescription and illicit #opioids. Opioid-related adverse drug events (#ORADEs), physical dependence, development of opioid use disorder (#OUD), and opioid #overdose have become an increasingly common part of medical practice. Fortunately, clinicians and #healthcare systems have the power to reverse the #opioidcrisis by transforming their practices. The Compass Opioid Prescribing and Treatment Guidance Toolkit holds resources to help clinicians and healthcare facilities with the following:

-A strong focus on how #nonopioid pain management methods can be optimized to limit new opioid #prescriptions

-Information on how to implement #riskmanagement and #harmreduction strategies for patients on chronic opioid therapy (#COT), including #naloxone and #overdoseprevention #patienteducation resources

-#Controlledsubstance agreements and planning forms that delineate #patient expectations and sets the rules of the road for your practice

-Provider education on how to #diagnose and treat patients struggling with #OUD
